

Wildlife services kills Mar 2013 and Jan-Mar 2014 (from CWD sample sheets received in FOIA package.)

2013

Mar 28 2013 9 1 fawn (age 0.5), 8 adult females (age 1.5 or greater)

2014

Jan 6 2014 16 0 fawns, 4 adult males, 12 adult females

Jan 7 2014 13 2 fawns, 6 adult males, 5 adult females

Jan 8 2014 14 2 fawns, 6 adult males, 6 adult females

Jan 9 2014 10 2 fawns, 2 adult males, 6 adult females

Feb 24 2014 26 5 fawns, 8 adult males, 13 adult females

Feb 25 2014 19 3 fawns, 7 adult males, 9 adult females

Mar 18 2014 8 3 fawns, 1 adult males, 4 adult females

2014 Total 106 17 fawns, 34 adult males, 55 adult females

This list indicates 7 killing sessions in 2014. Our surveillance team did a good job of detecting the kills. We knew about 4 for sure and suspected a 5th. On the other two very cold January nights we didn't have any very late surveillance.

We knew about Jan 6th. On Jan 7 most of the roads closed on the 6th were open at about 7:30 pm, when Carol was out but I think it was possible they started later or in a very different part of the park. I don't think anyone was able to do the drive on the 8th. Both Luke and Bryan spotted them on the 9th, so we knew about that one.

Luke spotted them on both the 24th and 25th of February, so we knew those for sure.

There was suspicious activity reported on March 18 but it wasn't very clear there was any actual killing. (that was the night of the fewest kills – only 8)
